- Provides highly readable short stories without needing scientific in-depth knowledge and is enhanced with illustrations

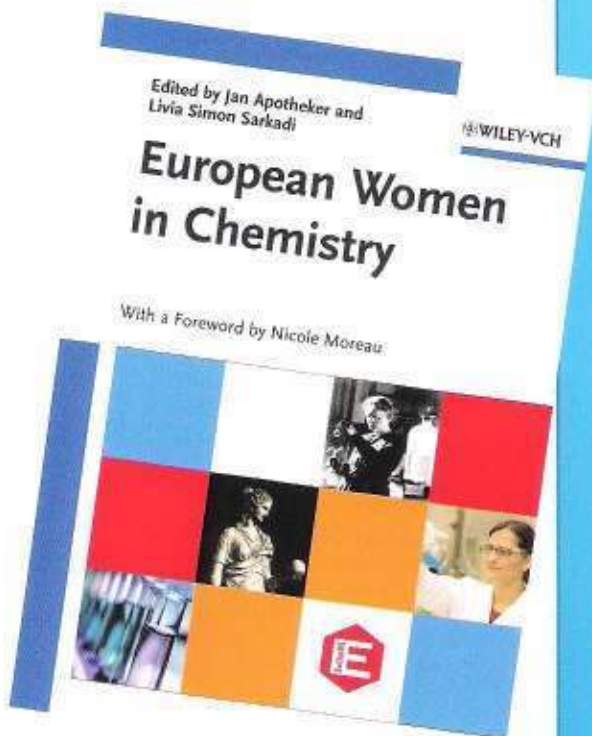

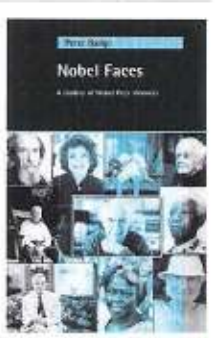
